

WINTER & SPRING LEAGUES COMPETITIVE FOOTBALL

U7's & U8's – These age groups will play in friendly leagues where we will adjust the teams periodically to ensure that the games are as even as possible. The competitive element will come by the way of 3 festivals, each run over a period of 2 weeks. One in the winter and one in the spring, a bit like a summer tournament but run over 3 Sundays.

U9's, U10's & U11's - The season will be split into 2 halves, Winter and Spring and will consist of 2 competitive trophy event leagues of 6-8 teams along with a number of friendlies

U12's - The season will be fully competitive. 8 teams playing each other twice once as the home team and once as the away plus the addition of our new Champions League style Malc Jones Cup in memory of our late Life President

All age groups will also have a post season festival in May at the end of the season as part of the league. Any U12 competitive games that are postponed will be rescheduled at the back of the competitive block.

Any friendly games postponed may just drop out of the system.

 referees and are all registered with both Nottinghamshire FA and also with Kickstart League.
- After every game, team managers will go into the Full Time system and mark the referees on their performance. This information is used by both the county FA and Kickstart to identify any issues and any referees excelling in their duties.
- There is still a shortage of Referees in the County however we are pleased to announce that Kickstart have secured all of the referees we require to fulfil all fixtures for the 2025/2026 season. A big thank you to all of our referees for their continued support

DE REGISTERING

HOW TO DE-REGISTER A PLAYER

To de-register a player, all you need to do is return the players registration ID card to your Football Reception or to the League Secretary/Registrar direct, then using "Club Portal" System team administrators must go in to the players record and select "CANCEL REGISTRATION" thus the player(s) will be removed from your team. There is no charge for this process.

Following the above, the league will cancel the registration of the player(s) to enable the Secretary/Player Registration Officer for the club to detach the player where required using the Player Registration system. - Marking which players attended and started the game and who was sub
- Who scored the goals from your team
- Who were your players of the match should you wish to select any
- Final scores using your team code (text message)
- This needs to be completed for every game by every team by Monday evening 7pm — FINES WILL BE ISSUED FOR ANYONE NOT COMPLYING
- You will also receive any notifications regarding fixtures that affect you as soon as we are notified i.e. a change of referee, change of kick off etc.

An administration fee of £10 will be charged to your club.

A administration of £20 will be charged to your club.

As you can see, the sooner you can let us know about a cancellation, the less hassle and expense it is for everyone involved.

Please do not wait until the next set of fixtures are published to let us know of your unavailability.

Please do not assume that if you currently do not have a fixture, that you definitely will not. A cancellation may take place causing a fixture to be generated.

The matchday fee will be charged to your club.

Also A 3 point award will be made to the opposition if it is an U12 competitive game or automatic disqualification if it is a cup game

Check your fixtures regularly, DO NOT print out a list of fixtures to hand out to your Players' Parents/Carers. Fixtures are subject to change up to Friday evening, although this is rare. If a fixture has changed with less than seven days until the fixture, you will receive a text notification from the Fixtures Secretary.

COMPLAINTS OR QUERIES REFEREES

Ensure you score your Referee 60 points or below on the Full Time system and advise your Club Secretary to send a report to the League Secretary, copied to the Referees Secretary. This report must be sent in writing by email within 2 days of the match (excluding Sundays), in order for the matter to be investigated.

COMPLAINTS OR QUERIES RESPECT

If you have any complaints regarding non-adherence to the 'Respect' programme, a report must be submitted in writing detailing which parts of the 'Respect' programme you consider have been breached.

This report must be sent from your Club Secretary in writing (by email) within 2 days of the match (excluding Sundays), in order for the matter to be investigated.

Please note that if the complaint involves a child welfare issue, this must be reported to your Club's Child Welfare Officer who will liaise with the League's Welfare Officer.







Law Updates 2024/25



Heading Guidance

2024/25

- Deliberate heading the ball is an offence punishable by an indirect free kick
- The indirect free kick is taken at the point where the ball was deliberately headed, except:
 - Where a player deliberately heads the ball within their own penalty area, the referee will stop the game and restart with an indirect free kick to the opposition from the nearest side line of the penalty area where the offence took place.
- No disciplinary sanction; except for persistent infringement

U7's – U10's







Touchline Restart Guidance


Touchline Restart:

- When the whole of the ball passes over the touchline, on the ground or in the air, instead of a throw-in, a pass-in or dribble-in is awarded.
- A kicker taking a pass-in may choose to touch the ball again before it is touched by another player

At the moment of delivering the ball:

- The ball must be stationary on the touchline at the point where it left the pitch; only the kicker may be off the pitch.
- All opponents must stand at least 5 yards from the point on the touchline where the pass-in or dribble-in is to be taken.
- A goal cannot be scored directly from a pass-in.
- The ball is in play when it is kicked and clearly moves.







What is dissent?

'DISSENT BY WORD OR ACTION'

- Covered under Law 12 and is in the opinion of the referee.
- A player is cautioned if guilty of dissent by word or action.
- Kicking the ball away could be either dissent or delaying the restart of play depending on context.
- Using offensive, insulting or abusive language or gestures is not dissent!



What is dissent?

'Sin Bins

- Encourage use Sin Bin protocol to improve player behaviour
- Show the yellow card and show the direction to the technical area
- Times: 10mins (90minute game) 8mins everything under 90mins
- Second yellow card = send off


